Escape to Festivals, Floral & Fun

Exploring Hokkaido's floral landscape during the blooming season is a delightful experience, and attending seasonal festivals adds an extra layer of cultural and natural richness to your journey. Unlike the rest of Japan, cherry blossoms bloom from May. The perfect place to take part in Hanami park parties! If you're visiting in late July, consider attending the Furano Belly Button Festival. While not directly related to flowers, this quirky event features music, dance, and local food, adding a fun element to your trip. In August, Sapporo comes alive during the Bon Odori street festival. Hokkaido's natural beauty extends beyond flowers and festivals, so we use this time to explore the diverse landscapes, hot springs, and delicious local cuisine throughout this trip.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Q: How much free time can we expect?

A: During our visits to major cities, we like to give you a day to explore independently. In more rural areas, venturing out on your own can be an adventure (if you're up for it!). Just coordinate with your tour leader or guide for a meetup spot. Remember to carry your hotel's business card and, when in doubt, catch a taxi.

Q: Is Japan all fish, no meat?

A: In Japan, fish, rice, and miso soup are staples, but meat dishes are found everywhere. On our small group tours, you'll get a taste of many different types of dishes, so don't worry if you're not a fish fan – we'll make sure you won't go hungry!

Q: What about vegetarian, coeliac, or other food allergies?

A: It is vital we know if you have a food allergy or specific dietary requirement at time of booking. Restaurants do not take last-minute requests kindly. So, the more notice we can give them, the happier everyone will be on the tour. All dietary requirements will be considered once we are informed at time of booking.

Q: Do I have to sleep on a futon?

A: When staying in ryokans or minshuku's, the best way to embrace this culture is to sleep inside the tatami matted rooms which yes, are on a futon. However, if you prefer to have a bed, we will make this request. While we cannot guarantee it, we will do our best! Be sure to highlight this at time of booking.

Q: How much is the booking deposit?

Type 1. €400 | £350 | US\$500 | AU\$700 |CA\$600 per person* Type 2. €800 | £700 | US\$1,000 | AU\$1,400 | CA\$1,200 per person**

*All Deposits are based on Euro value. Currency Exchange fluctuations may differ at time of booking. **Type 2 deposit is requested on tours that include an internal flight.

All deposits are non-refundable.

Q: When do I pay final balance?

A: 90 days prior to your departure date.

Q: When should I book my flight?

A: As soon as you book the tour (if available to book - most airlines accept bookings up to 330 days prior).

Q: When do we get our travel document

A: You will have access to your OOMI Travel App within 2 months of your travel dates. Your final itinerary will be uploaded 2 weeks prior your start date. If you would like your Travel Pack posted, be sure to send us the best address at that time.

Q: Is my trip protected?

A: Yes, we are fully bonded, no matter what country you book from. To receive a copy of this policy, request with your travel consultant.

Q: What happens if I need to cancel my trip?

A: Deposits are non-refundable. Cancelation charges will apply from 90-days. See terms and conditions for details.

Q: What happens if OOMI Travel cancels a trip?

- A: You will be given 2 options:
- 1. Change to a different tour
- 2. Receive a full refund (including deposit)

Q: Should we expect to tip guides or tour leaders?

A: Although Japan is not a tipping culture, we suggest offering some sort of monetary gift to our guides. Details of this will be outlined in your Pre-Departure Letter which you will receive in your travel pack.

Q: Can we arrive earlier or leave later than the tour dates?

A: Yes, we can arrange your pre / post tour in Japan. In fact, we usually recommend you arrive one day earlier to the tour start date to acclimatize to the new time zone (JST).

Q: Will you still meet us at the airport if we arrive earlier? Or leave later?

A: Yes, as long as Oomi Travel has booked your pre or post-tour hotel nights.

WHEN TO BOOK

Our Small Group Tours have a maximum number of 12 guests per group so to avoid disappointment we recommend you book your place as early as possible (12 months in advance preferred).

HOW TO BOOK

To secure your place, a non-refundable booking deposit of €400 / €800 (or equivalent in your own currency) is required per guest. We accept all major credit cards. No credit card fees apply. The final balance of your tour is due 90 days prior. Deposits can be paid online or over the phone:

PAYMENT DEADLINES

Payment for all tours is required 3 months prior to your starting date. In the event a booking is made less than 3 months prior, full payment must be made within 7 days of booking date.

CANCELATION TERMS

If you need to cancel your place for any reason, after you pay your deposit, a written notification is required. Deposits remain non-refundable. Cancelation charges will depend on when you give us notice of your cancelation. Charges apply from 90 days prior to your tour date. Full details can be viewed inside our terms & conditions.

If we, the company, need to cancel your place due to unforeseen circumstances beyond our control, you will be given the option to change your date, move to an alternative tour, or receive a full refund. If we cannot find a suitable alternative, you will be offered a full refund.



TRAVEL DOCUMENTS

Upon booking, you will be sent an invoice detailing your payment schedule and travel dates. Your final itinerary will be uploaded to your **OOMI Travel App.** If you prefer to receive a full printed travel pack, we can post it to your address.

For all tours, a single occupancy supplement will apply. We do not pair people with other guests in the same room. Single Occupancy will be highlighted in your invoice and/or on our website www.oomitravel.com

SMALL GROUP TOUR HOTEL LISTS

The final hotel choice is confirmed before your final payment is made. Any hotel listed on website or literature is subject to change. In the event we cannot secure the hotels listed, we will provide a similar category hotel in each location. After your final payment is made, there may be exceptional or operational circumstances that require a further hotel change. You will be notified of this at the time

FLIGHTS

You are required to send us your E-ticket as soon as you have your flights booked. Transfers cannot be arranged without a copy of your E-ticket.

GROUP SIZE

Our Small Group tours have a maximum number of 12 guests. All published prices are based on a minimum number of 6 guests in any group. In the event the final number of guests is less than 6, don't worry, we will not cancel your trip. Instead, we operate them on a semi-escorted basis. Minor adjustments will be made such as; instead of having a full-time tour leader throughout, you will be met by local guides and assistants along the way.

TRAVEL INSURANCE

It is a condition of travel that each tour member obtains their own up to date travel insurance to cover medical, cancelation or accidental costs. If you are a resident in Ireland, we can include Travel Insurance in your booking.

SPENDING MONEY & CASH

Japan's currency is the Japanese Yen (¥). We recommend you have a minimum of ¥60,000 (€400) per person in cash at the start of your tour. While most services will accept credit cards as payment, there may be some smaller vendors who won't. So cash is important to carry. More information will be emailed to guests prior to departure in your travel pack and app.

LUGGAGE

When taking a bullet train on any of our small group tours, we will arrange to send your large suitcase from one hotel to the next. One suitcase per person is included. If you wish to send extra luggage in this way, you will be asked to pay locally. Depending on where we are sending your luggage to/from, you may need to pack an overnight bag. So, it is essential you have a smaller bag to pack a one or two night stay while your large case is en-route. A small backpack or in-flight suitcase will work (up to 10kg).

CLOTHES

Check the climate and temperature before you leave and bring clothes to suit the season. Japanese weather is very predictable so it should not be a problem planning your wardrobe. Wear layers if going into mountainous regions as the temperatures can drop when leaving the city.

VISAS, AIRPORT SECURITY & DOCUMENTATION
